- Ulyanovsk (RUS)

Simbirsk - called Ulyanovsk since May 9, 1924 - was founded in 1648 by voivode Bogdan Khitrovo as an outpost on the borders of the Moscow State for protection against nomads and expanding borders of the Russian state. By the beginning of the 17th century, the city had become an economic and trade center of the Middle Volga region. The outcome of the peasant war led by Stepan Razin was decided near the walls of Simbirsk. Simbirsk fortress withstood the siege, and Razin was forced to go down the Volga.

At the beginning of the 19th century a theater, a hospital, a gymnasium were opened in the city, then later - a library and a monument to N. M. Karamzin. During these years, the Trinity and Nicholas Cathedrals were built. The life stories of many prominent people are linked to Simbirsk (Ulyanovsk), such as historian N. M. Karamzin, writer I. A. Goncharov, poet N. M. Yazykov, D. D. Minaev, painters A. A. Plastov and D. I. Arkhangelsky. The leader of the 1917 revolution, V. I. Ulyanov (Lenin), was born here and spent here the first 17 years of his life.







Today's Ulyanovsk is a city of regional importance with a population of over 620 thousand people. It is located on the Volga Upland, on the banks of the Volga River (Kuibyshev reservoir) and the Sviyaga River, in the place where their watercourses are getting closer.











Ulyanovsk is now one of the major industrial and cultural centers of the Volga region. It is the center of mechanical engineering (the famous UAZ off-road vehicles are manufactured here), aviation (Aviastar-SP JSC is the country's largest enterprise for the production of aviation equipment. The plant's specialization is the production of cargo aircrafts). This is the first region in Russia that has implemented a wind farm project and managed to localize production of wind power equipment. A territory of advanced socio-economic development has been established in Ulyanovsk.





Ulyanovsk is also actively developing in the field of sports. The region and the city host championships and Russian cups. There are new sports arenas and stadiums. In August

2017, the Ulyanovsk region hosted one of the biggest sporting events - the 1st Festival of national sports and games of the Commonwealth of Independent States.

In 2018, Ulyanovsk hosted the international sports forum "Russia – country of sports". More than 3 thousand people took part in the event, including leaders of federal and regional authorities, representatives of the Olympic movement, international and all-Russian sports organizations, scientific and business communities, world's leading athletes. Traditionally, the forum agenda included issues of popularization of physical culture and sports in Russia. The quest of honor was the president of Russia V.V. Putin.









In June 2018, Ulyanovsk was honored to host the Russian Archery Championship and the Russian Crossbow and Archery Championship. More than 400 athletes from 36 regions of the country came to Ulyanovsk to compete and determine the best shooters in the country.

The formal opening was held in the main square of the city, where the governor of the Ulyanovsk region Sergey Morozov welcomed the athletes.









For the first time, two Russian championships were held simultaneously. Competitions were conducted on the sporting venues of Ulyanovsk State Technical University and the Volga Stadium.









In August 2019, the World Cup in Crossbow Shooting will be held in Ulyanovsk.

The championship will be held at two sports venues in Ulyanovsk: the Central Stadium "Trud" and the stadium of Ulyanovsk State Polytechnic University.


Athletes from more than 30 countries will take part in the world cup. All participants and guests of the competition will be offered an extensive cultural program.
