IMPORTANCE OF CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULES

- The success of a Championship depends on the Schedule !

- Schedule affects and controls all stages and aspects of the Championship
 - Organization of the Accomodation
 - Organization of the Transportation
 - Organization of the Staffing (Officials, Technicians, Volunteers,...)
 - Organization of the TV and Media Coverage





CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULING MATCH



DEADLINES AND APPROVAL OF SCHEDULES

Preliminary Competition Schedules must be submitted to the IAU HQ

- WCH ECH WC 12 months

Preliminary Competition Schedules must be send to Federations

- WCH ECH WC 6 months

Final Competition Schedules must be prepared and distributed immediatly after the Final Entry Deadline (2 months before)

The latest changes in the Final Competition Schedule must be communicated immediatly, and are only possible until the Technical Meeting!

Preliminary and Final Competition Schedules must be approved by the IAU, that means by the IAU Secretary General and the IAU Technical Delegate





CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULING MATCH



BASIC ELEMENTS AND SCHEDULE STANDARDS

- Every Championship must have:
 - Arrival Day
 - Official Training Day
 - Competition Days
 - Departure Day
- Every Event must have:
 - Elimination Rounds (if necessary)
 - Qualification Round (Start Time)
 - Final (Final Reporting Time and Final Start Time)
 - Victory Ceremony





CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULING MATCH



BASIC ELEMENTS AND SCHEDULE STANDARDS

- Championship Schedule must also contain:
 - Equipment Control Working Time
 - Optional Events (Opening Ceremony, Closing Ceremony)
- Trainings, Competitions and Finals – all must be conducted according to the Rules – NO EXCEPTIONS
- Separate Training Schedule (Unofficial / Official Training is helpful as well.





CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULING MATCH



SPECIFIC GUIDELINES FOR SEPARATE EVENTS / FINALS

- 10m / 30m Timing considerations
 - Ranges should be open at least 45 min before the Start Time, and it must be the same for all relays
 - Target preparation and check by the Jury must be finished before CRO calls athletes to the line
 - CRO must call athletes to the line 15 min before the Time Start
 - Competition Time is always according to the Rules

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR PREPARING SCHEDULES

○ Range Capacity Calculations

- How many targets can be used per event?
- How many event can be conducted in suitable light conditions?
- How many series per day are possible in the ranges?
- Day with finals : less hours for Qualifications rounds (work backwards from the Final Start Time.
