## 1 IMPORTANCE OF CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULES

**The success of a Championship depends on the Schedule!**

Schedule affects and controls all stages and aspects of the Championship

- Organization of the Accommodation
- Organization of the Transportation
- Organization of the Staffing (Officials, Technicians, Volunteers, ...)
- Organization of the TV and Media Coverage

# CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULING

## 2 DEADLINES AND APPROVAL OF SCHEDULES

- Preliminary Competition Schedules must be submitted to the IAU EC
  - WCH: 8 months; WC: 8 months in advance
- Preliminary Competition Schedules must be send to Federations
  - WCH: 6 months; WC: 6 months in advance
- Final Competition Schedules must be prepared and distributed immediately after the Final Entry Deadline.
- Latest changes in the Final Competition Schedule must be communicated immediately, and are only possible until the Technical Meeting!
- Preliminary and Final Competition Schedules must be approved by the IAU, that means by the IAU chairman of the TC-Field and the IAU Technical Delegate

# CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULING

## 3 BASIC ELEMENTS AND SCHEDULE STANDARDS

- Every Championship must have:
  - Arrival Day
  - Official Training Day
  - Competition Days
  - Departure Day
- Every Event must have:
  - Training
  - Competition Rounds (Preparation and Sighting Time)
  - Final (Final Reporting Time and Final Start Time)
  - Victory Ceremony







# CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULING



---

## 3 BASIC ELEMENTS AND SCHEDULE STANDARDS

- Championship Schedule must also contain:
  - Equipment Control Working Time
  - Optional Events (Opening Ceremony, Closing Ceremony, Receptions, ...)
- Trainings, Competitions and Finals – all must be conducted according to the rules – NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Championship Schedules should be prepared as a Pictorial and a List version.
- Separate Training Schedule (Unofficial / Official Training) is helpful as well.

# CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULING

## 5 BASIC ELEMENTS AND SCHEDULE STANDARDS

### Unofficial Training

- According to the current IAU Rules unofficial trainings must be scheduled on a day before the official training

### Official Training

- According to the current IAU Field Rules the athlete must be allowed to train on the allocated competition firing point





# CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULING

## 5 BASIC ELEMENTS AND SCHEDULE STANDARDS

### Range Capacity Calculations

- Identify number of firing points which can be used
- Determine shooting hours (sunlight, legal restrictions)

## 6 SPECIFIC GUIDELINES FOR SEPARATE EVENTS / FINALS

### Timing Considerations

- Ranges should be open at least 60 min before the Start Time
- Target preparation and check by Jury must be finished at least 15 min before the DOS calls athletes to the line
- Sighting targets must be visible at least 15 min before Preparation and Sighting Time starts
- The DOS must communicate the starting time of the competition at least 15 min before the competition starts
- Competition Time is always according to the Rules







# CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULING



---

## 6 SPECIFIC GUIDELINES FOR SEPARATE EVENTS / FINALS

### Finals Timing Considerations

- The finals must be scheduled on a day after the competition
- Victory Ceremony could be conducted immediately after the Final
- Duration of Finals (+ additional time for possible S-offs)
  - At least 60min per category (including sighting shots)
