

## **Program for the preparation of IAU international judges for field crossbow**

Actually the IAU field crossbow division have 12 high qualified and accredited International Judges from 7 different countries (B, CR, CZ, F, GE, H, and RU) and 27 accredited Field judges from four countries (A, GE, CZ and RU, see appendix No. 1). For this year the number of Judges could be enough, but for the near future will we need to prepare new Field Judges as International Judges. Many of existing IJ's have accreditation till the next year, and the year 2019 could be a right opportunity to create new IJ's from existing FJ's.

This year we have actualised the existing document for filed crossbow judges, the IAU Judges guideline (see on IAU website). This is the basic guideline for all judges, for National judges, Field Judges and International Judges. Now is the right time to inform all national member federations, to translate it to national languages and publish on national web sites.

The next step could be a creating a new guideline for IAU Field Judges Course. I prepare a draft for organizers and applicants of such a course similar to existing ISSF way (see as appendix No. 2). We need to clarify how to prepare the FJ Course and responsibility of organizers, instructors and applicants. The main target is to put a chance for main national member federations of IAU easy to create more Field Judges. I propose for the near future connect all (or maximum) IAU international events like EC and WC for teaching and accrediting of new FJ's and IJ's. This draft of guideline must be finish and publish sun as possible.

Many of existing problems with judging we also discus during the IAU Field Technical Committee meetings. I hope, that on the next TC meeting in Pärnu we will continue with it.
